





TERMS & CONDITIONS

By registering for the IFAWPCA Convention, delegates agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:

(1) Registration and payment deadlines

- Full payment must be received by the registration to confirm participation in the event.
- IFAWPCA Delegates and Accompanying person: Delegates must confirm their registration and complete payment by 31 October 2026. After this time, the registration will be considered final, and no further changes or cancellations will be accepted.
- Any overseas transactions or bank fees, including but not limited to foreign exchange charges or international bank fees, will be borne by the participant.
- TCA reserves the right to charge back any such fees to participants if incurred.
- Thailand Conference Delegates: Registration deadline to be advised.

(2) Cancellation and Refund Policy

- Before the respective deadline: Delegates may cancel their registration and receive a refund, minus any applicable administrative fees.
- After the respective deadline: No refunds will be issued for cancellations or non-attendance.
- All cancellations must be submitted in writing to admin@ifawpca2026.com 3 days before closing date (31 October 2026).

(3) Substitution of Delegate

- If a delegate is unable to attend, a substitute may be designated. Substitution requests must be submitted in writing to admin@ifawpca2026.com by 31 October 2026.
- After this deadline, substitutions will not be accepted.

(4) Event Changes and Cancellations

- TCA reserves the right to modify the conference program, speakers, dates, or venue if necessary.
- TCA is not responsible for any expenses incurred by delegates in the event of changes or cancellations, due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, governmental restrictions, acts of war, terrorism, strikes, civil unrest, or other emergencies. Delegates acknowledge that TCA shall not be liable for any indirect, consequential, or incidental damage resulting from the cancellation or rescheduling of the event due to a Force Majeure event.
- If a Force Majeure event renders the event impossible, impractical, or illegal to proceed, TCA may cancel or reschedule the event by providing written notice to all affected parties or rescheduled the event within a reasonable timeframe.

(5) Refunds and Costs (for conference)

- If the event is canceled and not rescheduled, participants shall be entitled to a refund of any fees paid, less any reasonable expenses incurred by TCA up to the point of cancellation.

(6) Official Hotel Cancellation Policy and Refund

All official hotels are strictly non-refundable. TCA shall have no obligation to refund any hotel-related fees, and guests acknowledge that full charges for the entire stay and will apply in the event of cancellation, amendment, or no-show. All regulations depend on conditions of the hotel


(9) Data Protection and Privacy


